Year 5 - Beach Trip

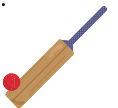

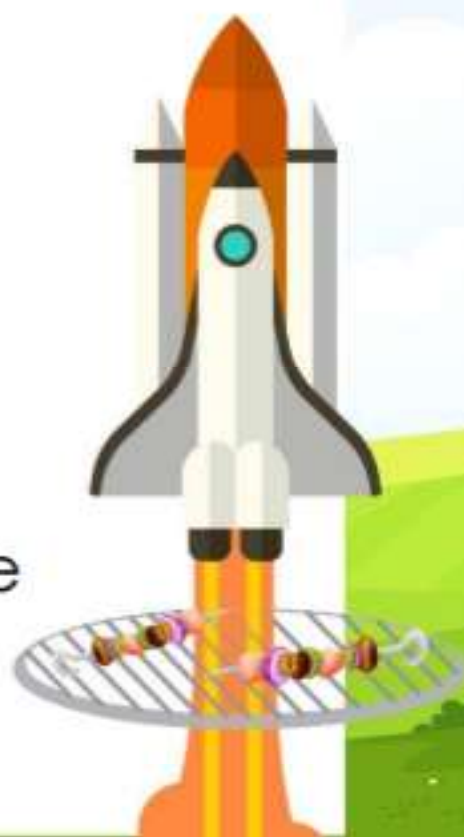
