Free School Meals Update

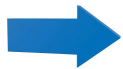
From September 2026, Free School Meal eligibility is expanding, meaning more families receiving Universal Credit may qualify.

If you receive Universal Credit and your child does not currently receive Free School Meals, we encourage you to apply now via the East Sussex County Council Free School Meals Portal to ensure support is in place for the new school year.

If your child already receives Free School Meals, there is no need to reapply. The local authority will carry out eligibility reviews automatically.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 families: Children will continue to receive Universal Infant Free School Meals automatically. However, if you receive Universal Credit or have a low household income, please still apply, as this can unlock additional funding for our school through the Pupil Premium.
